1. World Economic Forum Davos 2012 Sustainable Society.

The World Economic Forum in Davos, Switzerland is looking ahead to the Earth Summit in Rio De Janiro in June 2012.

The original earth summit in Rio De Janiro in 1992, following the declaration of the Earth Charter in 1987, instigated in turn by the then Norwegian Prime minister Gro Harlem Bruntland, and the Bruntland report, will see the United Nations return to Rio D Janiro in June 2012 for Rio + 20. In turn this will help the world to achieve its 20/20 (2020) targets for carbon emissions and sustainability as a academic teaching method as well as a new world governmental strategy.

Recently the controversy over Genetically Modified foods (Monsanto) and the surrounding agricultural system and the worldwide system of agriculture changed to adapt to its new harvest and retailing around the world have been banned in [Europe and elsewhere but not banned as yet in the USA.](#)

Why did this happen at all ? farming practices and sustainability for millennia went hand in hand. Not until bad farming practices incurred as a result of pressures forced upon farmers by the financial system did we arrive at this unnatural state of agrarian mismanagement. [Genetically Modified Crops and farming.](#)

As the video shows there is a pressure to improve crop yields. This is a natural desire, but when it is pressure to meet yields which are induced by paying banks loans, then as the bank loans are unrepayable, the pressure forces other methods which farmers should not have to endure. Further farmers do not buy in products at the wholesales they trust products are approved and good. Cost benefit analysis (any method currently employed) does not take this into account.

This pressure at national level existed before the Bretton Woods agreement 1945 – 1947 and before the World Bank and IMF Gatt, Nafta trade facilitators extended its more contemporary aims.

Writing on Pesticides and Herbicides, Alloway states.

“Problems with environmental persistence were first detected in 1966 when researches looking for signs of DDT accumulation, found their results being obscured by other compounds similar to DDT. These were later identified as PCB”¹ which cause liver damage and skin irritations.

Agriculture and the slurry it produces may well be accumulating ‘results being obscured’ especially when farmers in America identified by the MacLibe case found that concrete aggregates were added to cattle feed to produce heavier cattle for market. <http://www.mcspotlight.org/case/>

“The animal husbandry practiced today is only concerned with economics. The comfort and welfare of the animal is only important if there is the chance that the animal will fail to achieve marketability. I

participated in this transition. For many years I believed the end justified the means. Today I regard the methods used in most animal production as barbaric and inhumane. The use of confinement and chemical therapy to increase weight gain is self defeating to the point where the more animals that are crowded together, the more chemical therapy is needed to stave off massive death loss. The conditions in the present day feedlot are adequate if the weather cooperates. However, if too much rain or snow comes to area the feedlots become death traps for confined animals”² &

“I have witnessed first-hand the problems associated with animal production and the degradation of the land base. We are placing a tremendous financial burden on the farmers and ranchers. **In many cases the production costs incurred by present agricultural practices are equal to, if not more than the sale price of commodities.** This means that most farmers and ranchers are producing at a loss or at best breaking even. Their only solution, in many cases, is to produce more animals on the same acreage and **the land base is showing the stress of overgrazing**”³ &

“Well, the thing that really brought it to the fore-front was in 1979 when I ended up paralysed from the waist down. The doctor told me that I had a tumour on my spinal cord, it was on the inside of the cord, I had less than a one chance in a million. When somebody gives you the odds of one in a million it really gets your attention. That was right after I had to admit that we had eliminated the birds, killed the trees, my brother had died of Hodgkin's Disease, which we found caused by dioxin from the weed spray we were using 245T better known as Agent Orange in Vietnam”⁴

It is of course absurd that **pharmaceutical companies** exist making Billions out of expensive pills when [ESSIAC](#) [ESSIAC](#) and other proven cancer cure treatments (discovered years ago) work ? (essiac = cassie = rene m cassie)

The **Common Agricultural Policy was established in 1957 by the Treaty of Rome** and introduced in Ireland in 1973 when Ireland joined the EEC. Prior to this the Agriculture industry was considered a Primary sector economy, with resulting secondary industry exports and manufacturing in decline. Although this depends on how we assess decline, as the Cap moves towards a 20/20 vision for sustainability. Ultimately CAP is governed by two problems (amongst other concerns) economics, and farmers reliant on making a living. Farmers can only buy products they access in the wholesalers, and trust they are healthy and safe. Alternatively they have to downsize their farms to return to more natural methods, if they do not wish to buy large machinery on credit.

Whilst many may abuse the system, Howard Lyman (quoted above) noticed a sharp increase in these practices into which he became entwined as a farmer from 1963. He was an animal and grain farmer from 1963 to 1983,

after graduating in 1961 with a BS degree in general agriculture from Montana state university and first used natural and organic methods. MacDonald's lost the case.

Producing soils which are clean and safe of course occurs naturally, just as natural rock formations such as limestone cleans and purifies water running over and through it, is possible.

“My own observations are it is reasonable to extend the concept of Albrecht's ideal soil for all crops to suggest that it represents the a biological optimum soil in which all plants will thrive”⁵

William Albrecht believed that a lack of organic matter in soils and a lack of minerals occurring naturally would produce poor crops and poor animal livestock, and this is without the harmful effects from other sources⁶

Soil is therefore a precious commodity, a study in 2004⁷ has shown that pregnant woman carry traces or are exposed to DDT still, whilst the **Centre of disease control and prevention in the USA** factsheet states “A small portion of the population had measureable DDT. Most of the population had detectable DDE”⁸ and despite the legislative ban DDT has persisted to be produced and used in the USA up to 1985.

[In turn removing trees removes soil and water becomes polluted and soils thin.](#)

Monsanto which modifies DNA in plants by causing tumours in the plant to insert modified DNA, or using a ‘Gene gun’ to achieve same, so that it can resist its own herbicides allowing increased spraying of the herbicides, is clearly insane. Whilst this may rid us of weeds and competing crops to the grain or corn it also produces an increase exponentially in the eradication of insects and worms or bacteria in our soil which decrease its fertility. It does however increase yield and profits, although some would say that debt as GDP is a false profit

Whilst biodiversity is interrelated soil improvements improve trees growth and both produce purer water.⁹

So says Rachel Carson whose book Silent Spring pointed out that pesticides and (today) all other artificial additives to soils kill everything. With no worms or bugs we have dry lifeless soil which even if fallow (set aside) will take generations to recover if at all. There are natural and harmless fertilizers which act to improve yield and crops and our health. Changes to these methods will not reduce farmer's lifestyles, financially but will improve health in the epidemic of ill health farmers suffer.

Whilst we are wondering if the Ozone layer and carbon credits (con) are affordable, looking to the sky, we have missed the other great destruction of Mother Earth.

And with vast areas of the earth untilled not growing food, there is no food shortage only a supply shortage which is causing the prices to rise.

In any case synthetic chemicals may suffer a shortage due to peak oil, here is Richard Douthwaite's view on peak oil. [Richard Douthwaite has recently passed away \(RIP\) and during his ill health a friend and colleague Bruce Darrell gave his lecture at the following conference in Ireland October 2011](#) (it will enlarge)

Whilst there is oil it is becoming too expensive to extract and Fracking simply makes the water table and land around it uninhabitable. Ireland in any case has its licenses (exploration) groomed to a select few and its oil and gas should be nationalised.

RADIANT energy is real but like Tesla's "wireless" electricity the patent was bought out, and locked away as having never existed in order to maintain DC as a direct and metered supply of electricity instead of AC. The [CIS Insurance building in Manchester sells its excess energy back into the grid](#). (why do we have an energy crisis, with economists examining GDP balloons, and fiscal impossibilities?) Photovoltaic's, BIPV and OPV (organic photovoltaic's) are becoming extremely efficient, and will/can store energy in Hydrogen batteries which are increasingly safe and long lasting.

Whilst energy prices are manipulated to defy supply and demand statistics (by war or rumour of war) inflation by high energy costs is a secondary cause of inflation, and GDP growth caused by interest on loans of our own money to ourselves at interest is the first and this is the result when applied to farming techniques.

New technologies of course cause unemployment as well as employment, and the unemployment is outdoing the employment, which is bad news for Unions and wage increases.

Richard Douthwaite *The Growth Illusion. Pages 326 - 328*

“Indeed the introduction of any technology is as potentially destructive of the existing web of complex economic and social interrelationships that bind communities and nations as is the release of a genetically engineered organism to relationships within the natural world. For a generation that has grown up to be excited by and supported of technological advance- even the term itself con-notes progress-such a radical change in attitudes is a major step. Henceforward, before they are released into the world, new technologies should be put through searching safety procedures based on the assumption that they are guilty until proven innocent. Hitherto, our assumption has been entirely the other way.

Even old technologies can pose a serious threat if they are carried out in a new location. Alto is a village high in the hills behind the Algarve in Portugal, about ten kilometres from the warm springs at Monchique to which tourists drive from the coast. Until 1950, when a road to Alto was opened, its people were forced to live virtually self-sufficient lives because everything had to be carried in and out by donkey. Only cork, medronho (the local spirit, made from the berries of a tree that grows on the scrubby hillsides), sweet chestnuts, pigs and goats were sold to the outside world. With the proceeds the people purchased and carried in iron for tools and donkey shoes from the mines in Aljustrel, seven days’ trek to the north, as Robin Jenkins tells us in his beautifully written and moving account, “The road to Alto’ (1979). Rice came from Saboia, two days away, almonds were brought up from the Algarve, a day or two away; cigarettes and other manufactured goods came from the railway town of San Matrcos, a three-day round trip; salt came from Portimao, four days there and back. As a result,

Life consisted of growing and making what you could from what was available locally. There is hardly a plant an old peasant cannot give you a use for. Grasses for making sacks and string and washing greasy dishes, willows for baskets , pine for chairs and tables, oak for doors, cork for a hundred and one odd tasks, including plates and cups, herbs for all manner of medicines. Local life was fashioned out of what happened to be available. It blended with the environment because it was almost totally a product of that environment, day in,

day out. In the end, the local landscape cannot be understood without the peasants and the peasants cannot be understood without the local landscape.

For a millennium, life in Alto was almost entirely the product of a limited technology working within a particular geology and micro-climate. People ate what they could grow at this altitude and latitude and they kept the animals which thrived under the same conditions. They worked to maintain the standard of subsistence living that their energies and their technology allowed. And experience over many years, handed down from generation to generation, told them how much energy it was worth putting into growing potatoes or olives, or into keeping pigs. They never made any quick, intensive effort to grow a huge crop of something- what could they do with the surplus? It could not all be consumed. It could be stored for a limited period only and it could not be sold because the market was too far away. The environment and its isolation allowed a certain density of population and a certain standard of living and that is what the people worked to maintain over the centuries...

Life under such conditions had its own stoic and simple grandeur but for all the fragrant scent of the mimosas and the fleshy succulence of the fruits that grow in abundance, it was no Garden of Eden. Subsistence living is dependent on the local geology and can, as it does in Alto, result in localized diseases caused by mineral deficiencies in the rocks and soil. Until sardines became a regular part of local diet there was, for instance, a high incidence of goitre, especially amongst the poorer peasants who could not afford to buy the traditional salted cod that was eaten once a year to celebrate the pig-killing. Dietary deficiencies, in particular, a shortage of protein, produced people rarely more than 1 and a half metres (5ft) tall. And there were social problems too. There was a limit to the population that Alto could support but the population always tended to exceed the limit. The land inheritance laws determined the form of the solution to this problem. Poor peasants either without land or with insufficient land to make a living have left to go to work and live in the Altentejo or the Algarve and some have gone to Brazil or Mozambique. Alto has probably been an exporter of people for centuries. Even today, there is pressure on the land.

Aware of these restrictions and hardships, officials doubtless believed that by pushing ahead with the construction of the road they were bringing a better life to the people of Alto, Instead the project put the community into a decline which may prove terminal.

Suddenly goods that had to be hauled by donkey for hours or days along the old Moorish tracks came speeding down the new road in fifteen minutes from Monchique. The trucks rolled in with fertilizer and the peasants found that they could increase their yield almost overnight, The effect was dramatic. They found that they were producing well in excess of their own needs. For the first time they had sizeable crops to sell from their terraces. In fact, they had to sell them to pay for the fertilizer so they quickly got bound into the wider

economy. A new class of local entrepreneurs arose to exploit these new possibilities. Gradually, processes that had always been part of Alto's integrated existence were substituted by the "higher technology" of Monchique.

Motorbikes were purchased—they could carry more than a donkey and did not need daily attention. Plastic buckets replaced locally made pots and baskets. Concrete replaced the earth of the cottage floors. The windmill above the village was closed down and wheat was sent to the electrically powered mill in Monchique. It all seemed like progress.

But fewer donkeys meant that less manure was available for the terraces, and the people found that the chemical substitutes had to be applied in quantities that grew larger from year to year if they were to maintain crop yields. Moreover, fertilizers killed the worms, which had previously aerated the soil and brought up deep nutrients from within reach of plant roots. Without worms, the terraces became compacted and sterile, and with no humus to hold it, irrigation water quickly soaked away so that more had to be applied. Each application of water washed the fertilizer deeper into the soil away from the plant roots. “ Now it is impossible to grow anything either as a cash crop or for home consumption without giving the plants liberal doses of fertilizer” Jenkins says.

When potato prices failed to keep up with the price of fertilizers, the peasants found that there was no going back to their old ways, because unfertilized yields were too poor for them to subsist on and it would take years to restore the soils' fertility by natural means. As a result, many of them were forced to take up casual work to buy fertilizer to grow their own food. But then another effect of the road started to become apparent; the springs that provided irrigation water to the terraces for centuries began to dry up. The road had enabled outsiders to bring in bulldozers to clear the hillsides of their chestnuts, scrub and medronho trees in order to plant eucalyptus for paper pulp. A hectare of twelve-metre high eucalyptus transpires about a million litres of water a day and the new plantations were soaking up rainfall that had previously percolated through the earth to replenish the water table. By the time Jenkins left Alto in 1976, about 10 per cent of the terraces had lost their spring supply and the stable, sustainable way of life the water had made possible was dying. He mourns its loss:

If you sit by the windmill on the hill high above Alto and look down at the clusters of little cottages surrounded by their neat terraces far below, you haven't to marvel at what has been achieved here. The once isolated hamlet has existed in a state of balance with its natural environment for centuries. The balance was not planned but came about through an old odd assortment of factors, through trial and error. But once achieved, the knowledge of how to maintain it forever was laid down in the local customs and culture and passed on orally from generation to generation. There is a wealth of knowledge in those cottages down below and it will be lost

forever in a few years. The knowledge arose out of the annual struggle to grow enough food and some extra for next year's seed. It is not just knowledge about a mode of production with very limited capital on a particular bit of mountain. It is also knowledge about the means of "perpetual reproduction" of that simple mode of production. It is a very sophisticated form of knowledge, lying deep in the local culture, almost inaccessible to an outsider because it is not part of conscious dialogue and will never be revealed in discussion. It can be deduced only by carefully watching and, above all, by copying local practices in great detail. Then, and only then, can one begin to understand the wisdom of simple peasants and the limits to that wisdom that makes it impossible for them to cope with the consequences of things like fertilizers and eucalyptus plantations".¹⁰

There is no shortage of land in this world, only a shortage of land with trees, just look at every urban city why are trees not planted on every pavement, (with planned tree root expansion) and in every fallow field of which there are millions of acres worldwide where farmers are paid not to grow anything upon in every country, and this begs the question why there is a food shortage/crisis. (less supply means higher prices) Since this is not a system they created (farmers) they should be encouraged to plant forest of Oak and fruits.

The alternative, moving away from modern development to an older age is reckoned to be Luddite or nostalgia driven and entirely useless, as we need to create jobs and earn a living, as has been done for thousands of years. Therefore we need alternative planning for the planet, and sustainability is the vehicle to achieve this, yet the experiment has been criticised for being top down or at best sideways on development which does not attest to local democracy.

[A solution to this is Local Agenda 21, but not everyone agrees with it.](#)

The simple solution is to locally elect the Local Agenda 21 steering committee. Whilst many countries have limited funds, shortly Billions and Trillions will be made available to every local authority, but at what cost are those funds? The video above recited by a former real estate agent is unaware that the same banks which were fuelling the real estate bubble are funding the Local Agenda 21 development strategy, although with a different philosophy. Bush was instrumental to Local Agenda 21 as well as new [Hydrogen energy developments](#).

Amidst World Bank and IMF Gatt, Nafta, however the same cycle of debt, giving way to forced IMF loans, which eventually drive out exports and force the host country to import only continues. The host country faces rising unemployment due to debt payments by its government, which can only be paid off by another IMF loan, eventually there is nothing left.

Now this contradiction between real pollution, oil shortages and water and food problems, and a need worldwide to restrict debt and stock markets from ruining the planet, with the need to create well paid employment, against

the facts that the USA consumes more than most of the world put together means that affluence and the good life and prosperity needs to consider both views as being true and look elsewhere for solutions.

Looking for other solutions must consider that the working class around the world has a right to clean water, organic healthy food, affordable housing and land, free energy and all that nature gives and not just green sustainable living for the rich. This is especially true even for the oil agenda in America, which also caused mass poverty and a debt bubble and unemployment, giving rise to the housing bubble, causing unemployment (under Bush). With many buildings lying empty, redevelopment needs transparency and local economic democracy for the public. Amsterdam and Copenhagen have achieved sustainability and new super cities which have created work and a high quality of life.

We all deserve healthy food and organic living, for ourselves and our children, but challenging local agenda 21 by former real estate developers who also cornered the market via local banks and corruption may seem like sour grapes, yet there are concerns with local democracy and transparency to actual reach local people to obtain there share of *Prosperity*.

One solution although it is similar to other ideas is contained within the book *Prosperity without Growth* by Tim Jackson. The book could be entitled *Prosperity without Growth, debt, interest, private bonds or high taxes and inflation*, and move to issue a nations without attached interest (which transfer's wealth the wrong way, from those who have it to those who do not) as Douthwaite sternly warned. Building manufacturing and trade grow a society without need to grow its debt.

Being an Island with its own language and history of Napoleon and the City of London, Grattan's parliament still remains as one of Ireland's most prosperous eras.¹¹ Likewise Guernsey in a highly acclaimed paper (joke, but a serious one) has the following description.

“Unlike many countries, Guernsey has not delegated money creation to the central bank and has instead issued interest-free money from 1822 to 1836, stimulating the growth of economy after Napoleon's wars without creating public debt and without increasing taxes”¹²

Guernsey which also

“issues its own sterling coinage and banknotes. UK coinage and (English, Scottish and Northern Irish faced) banknotes also circulate freely and interchangeably”¹³

Prosperity without growth is forwarded by **Prince Charles** who agrees with the prosperity without growth plan for ecological growth and ecological sustainability, but people themselves do develop and are pollutants and need to be moved to cities out of the large landowning countryside.(he believes). Charles mother is the largest landowner on earth.

Yet taking this example of prosperity without debt growth, consider Guernsey and its sister Island Jersey who also developed without debt.

Once a population owns its own currency it can employ two methods.

- 1) Float its own currency and pay to build social needs, hospitals, schools roads, libraries, and **collect taxes to pay for them as many cities and town already do through their local authority** (municipal). However these schemes are financed by borrowing, from a currency which is borrowed as a debt into existence (such as the Federal Reserve) in the first place and is repaid at interest. Societies which do not have private non governmental (people public controlled) issuing banks do not have to pay any interest!
- 2) The secret of real banking, do all of the above, but collate all expenditure into a national debt, and with assets (hospitals, schools roads, libraries) add them as an asset against the national debt and then cancel the national debt without collecting taxes. This is how a circulating currency works, and whilst it does not solve the wage differential problem (skills are higher paid) it can accommodate a well paid average for social needs and allow extra skills to paid as fitting, hence it is best to begin with this non interest bearing bank to allow for works as society needs and solve by consensus the class problem later.
without creating public debt and without increasing taxes”¹⁴

Many hard hit societies are at this level of starting again, and whilst difficulties arise when importing goods to be paid in a foreign currency, fair trade, which needs an immediate solution, but which is way off on the horizon, can only therefore lead to a break up of the current amalgamation of states such as the EuroZone, USAzone and all globalisation unions to the past.

Africa has development problems, like the west it has corruption, but unlike the west (although this is decreasing especially over the last three years) it has no employment protection. Corporations enter build many polluting or dangerous factories and employ locals who live in corrugated iron shacks to work within them for pennies. If they die from bad working conditions which are also polluting the local soil and water and

agriculture generally, they can be replaced quickly. This is a development model. [Shell by Amnesty International](#)

Its not just a third world development model but we have seen Obama do the same in the USA with BP, and the Fracking horrors of the USA, and European countries.

Should the worldwide proletariat rise up and take over the means of production as Karl Marx predicted, and since manufacturing has declined and machines have taken over thousands of jobs by one machine, what are now the means of production, although doubtless they still exist as manufacturing remains in many countries. Research and Development institutions are one example and if thought about so is banking and financial institutions. What of rural areas who are also suffering? Trotsky predicted the movement of people from rural areas to the towns, but did he imagine the current swelling as has occurred in the last 50 years.

If local agenda 21 is undemocratic and planning is changing in ideology but with no real change socially and economically, what are the proletariat to do?

When the Soviets (pre 1917, Soviet simply means as one in harmony) which were also workers councils became a reality their success frightened western powers, and it was only after the 1917 revolution, that a new bank the People's Bank of the RSFSR (allowing non profit but, unfortunately selective loans only too circulate), this experiment lasted until 1922, when following Lenin's move to State Capitalism (New Economic Policy or NEP) the Gosbank or the State bank of the Russian Soviet Federative Socialist Republic was instigated allowing western monies to pour and the beginning of the end.

Local agenda 21 is either for all to prosper or it's nothing.

“The Anglo – Irish Bank Resolution Corporation or IRBC (formerly INBS) and its debts were guaranteed (without referendum or debate) by the Irish State in September 2008. By March 2011 they had paid €4 Billion and €3.11 Billion, to cover the outstanding Billions the Irish Government has to obtain external funding from the Central Bank (national Irish central bank) called (the) **Emergency Liquidity Assistance**”.¹⁵

These promissory notes **were unconditional** to Bondholders of Anglo – Irish bank. IMF loans, World Bank loans and loans to existing indebted countries all carry conditions, such as privatising everything out of the country and the loans cannot be passed on by the government to state nationals (individuals, or business or local authority). The reason for the latter is the IMF would do that themselves for higher interest, yet bonds which are promised higher interest rates than the nominal price (first produced price) to bondholders can be underwritten by taxpayers.

In Anglo's case “the promissory notes were paid to the IRBC. The IRBC uses the money to repay the Irish central bank for its emergency liquidity assistance (ELA) funding. Once the central bank receives the money, it deducts it from the value of its ELA liabilities. The money is effectively destroyed”.¹⁶

With €47.9 Billion left to pay soon, and €81 Billion in total (by 2031).

Therefore with European Central bank approval (technically) although they advised to let it collapse, money in the Irish State was produced out of thin air and made into an asset to pay liabilities, but for private gain only.

So magnify that to €100 Billion a year (Approx Irish GDP rate annually) and have a party. (do this in every country, but takeover first, sack the government, & finance minister and banks ...) [Anglo Not Our Debt](#)

2. World Economic Forum Davos 2012 *Economics*

2012 is a year in which much is expected, and one event which brought international focus was the world economic forum in Davos, Switzerland, its content and aims are displayed on its website, which was also broadcast live during its 5 day symposium comprising world leaders and academics. Klaus Swabb the Executive Chairman of the world economic forum, as a German economist he also founded the [Schwab Foundation for Social Entrepreneurship](#) a non profit foundation. This is a summary of his view in 2012. Klaus in Davos suggested;

“Capitalism needs New models of business and finance and solutions for alleviating poverty, we need longer term visions to build, rebond and rebind. Europe will not tolerate being divided, and needs that new vision and new models for Europe. Constructive new solutions are needed, chronic fiscal in-balances have caused havoc, and countries have allowed public debt to grow with a serious debt crisis threatening the world’s economic currencies” Angela Merkel also states that Europe will move away from Nuclear energy. See (towards the end) [Indymedia article on Framework for sustainability towards RIO earth summit 2012](#). (Rio + 20)

It is of course impossible that World debt since 1947 has risen to the current levels without government finance ministers and bankers noticing or becoming aware it is happening, hence the crisis is manufactured, but is nevertheless occurring. Of course it happens in unison and is a financial crime against the world. Since the worlds rich are already rich, what is the eventual aim of this continued position? As the world is globalised, is it to force a new system, in case the world objects.

Within this website and particularly articles on **A, B, B2** and this one **B3** are an attempt to show one economic model is possible not just in theory but in practice, and why any attempts to alleviate poverty are not economically impossible or difficult, indeed they are very easy and natural but only politically unpalatable (not impossible). **Realising that in a sane world we could at least achieve a new finance structure for children is correct, sensible and wise is beyond doubt.** Relating these alternative economic views in real time contrasting media broadcast interpretations helps people to analyze which political party or local official or corporation is telling the truth. Academia is only one barrier to change,

political class economics would rather see unnecessary austerity poverty and starvation / homelessness than make any changes in any system possible.

For instance Obama is both a Buddhist, a Zionist, a Champion of the civil rights movement and its opponent, and an imperialist killing hundreds of thousands of people, whilst Bush was a Christian, Conservative Liberal imperialist killing hundreds of thousands of people. Social Entrepreneurship then is also only possible by being out of the system completely or within capitalism but compromised. Yet even the compromise is watered down as (for example) the Tobin Tax (Robin Hood Tax) is accepted in principle in Europe but not by David Cameron or Irish Enda Kenny as they falsely claim it would lead to a reduction in Jobs ? when in fact it would create jobs and improve Social Entrepreneurship and Jobs by leaps and bounds.

This leaves the world in a quandary as of course the poor are getting poorer or more indebted into poverty. Like the occupy movement which now needs to take over the financial institutions and be occupant (avoiding evictions) and managers of that system as opposed to being on the outside. The occupy movement began with worldwide mass revolt which is ongoing and focused the crowds towards the banks and central banks, (as it should) the modern post 1960s roots of this movement began in [Seattle in 1999](#) ([the Battle of Seattle](#)).

It is clear that the revolution in Egypt and North Africa in general has only lead to an elite taking over the countries and wanting to form their own New Order

It is estimated that 550 thousand people have died since the Egyptian uprising began, and of course the Empire is not fighting for Americans, but one which has stolen its flag as President Jackson (and Lincoln) fought against on behalf of America inside America, and it is in 2012 that US figures (statistics) are being massaged to improve joblessness and the markets, all of which could have occurred ...in the “first 90 days”.

Europe is following this model keeping a central bank (in the USA they have 13 or so serving the Federal Reserve) in every country to serve one new (type) of European central bank. As is obvious the American model is also flawed and previous crisis (1973, 1988, 2003 and today from 2008) have not been saved by the Federal Reserve Bank but they were originally caused by them.

Currently David Cameron the British prime minister is following the line that he is a Euro Sceptic, but as the Conservative party have taken Britain further into Europe than any other party it is itself a sceptical position, which requires to be in Europe but not a part of it. (labour and the liberals adopt a similar position) This means that British people like Irish and all other members are under Europe's legal rule but the City of London will become the main lending mechanism to Europe through its creation the IMF.

Between the IMF and the World Bank originally devised in the Bretton Woods agreements in 1947, the only argument has been between the ideologies of how the new currency will operate. Will it follow John Maynard Keynes or follow the Chicago school and Milton Friedman (see also Frank Knight). Keynes favoured a working class approach whilst Friedman chose Monetarism and neo classical economic models which can be best explained as the type of economics that brought us slavery and colonialism. None really follow Marxism or indeed Adam Smith as Monetarism relies on unknown interest charges fluctuating to cause eventual currency imbalances, leading to one dominant currency and slavery for the rest. (Adam Smith actually preached fair trade not free trade, unfree GATT G20, tariffs and debt trade)

Recently the Pope has called for one Fiscal European office, (but he, Enda Kenny, or David Cameron will not have to pay the increased austerity the ESM treaty produces) which will control all of its countries, whilst David Cameron has announced that a Roman Catholic can succeed to the British throne after this was not allowed for the past 400 years (or so)

“Royal succession rules banning Roman Catholics from succeeding to the throne should be scrapped, the Prime Minister has said. David Cameron said Catholics should be able to become King or Queen, or marry the heir to the throne, but warned that changing the 1701 Act of Settlement would take time” <http://www.dailymail.co.uk/news/article-1378450/Royal-succession-reform-Kate-Middleton-Prince-Williams-baby-Queen.html>

This aspiration of course has not occurred as yet and in any multicultural society, it of course violates the Human rights of Roman Catholics and contradicts those human rights ? which when you think of the continued debate on Racism it is obvious it is not a genuine debate at all, and can hardly preach anti-racism.

With this in mind it is obvious that on planet earth we already live on a multicultural planet and the real story has been the mass movements of entire populations around the planet over the last 150 years

amidst huge engineered World Wars. Hitler favored less severe models of finance than Europe is currently aiming for ?

The truth as **A B**, **B2** & **B3** have gone to extreme lengths to try to show is that all these models are just different decorations in the same prison.

[“EU warns Hungary on central bank”](#) Hungary has recognised this problem i.e. that the economic debate is socially engineered to leave out the real alternative. Europe says Hungarians central bank must remain independent. This means independent of its own parliament, its people and its accountability to its population. Independence can also mean it remains independent of Europe, for Hungarians even within the European legal system (as Britain currently is, with the City of London outside democracy of its own population.)

Here you have the problem, inevitable growing debt levels into perpetuity for all countries, and a banking system which could operate in a United Europe (or America) without federal or union laws forcing people to join it. A non-legal Europe with one central bank or with many but all owned by the people in each sovereign state. The fact that both the debt system and legal treaties are synonymous can only lead to the current crisis, not in economics as this is staged but in political union which is unnecessary.

Hungary should be allowed to have its own economic system in or out of the legal union as should America. The American establishment wants the current situation as long as the IMF remains monetarist (which the European central bank is resisting) and more like its field of influence i.e. the World Bank.

Why did all of this arise, why are there jurisdictions within democracies outside of so-called democratic control.
